When setting camp there will be a staff row with 30 ft - then a cooks row, for a wall and fly per battery along with the cook fire, this will also be 30 ft. The remaining camp space will be company streets for **A-frames only NO WALLS OR FLYS**. These streets will not be as wide as we like them due to camping with the infantry. Be prepared to come in and unload as quickly as possible - **space and movement is limited**. Camp should be laid out by 3:00 pm on Wednesday and ready for set up. Unless you are staff, command staff or a cook you will be in a company street in an A frame.
