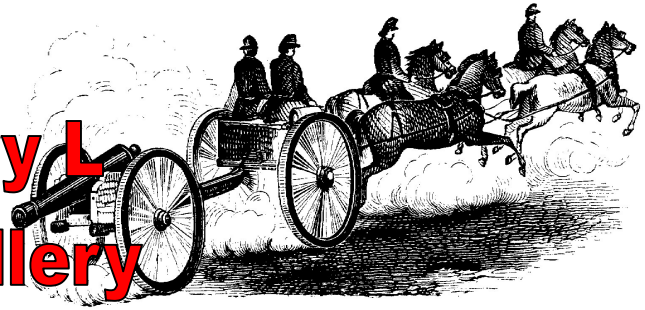


# Reynolds Battery L 1st NY Light Artillery
